The Transfiguration of the Lord & Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 6 August to 20 August 2023

The Transfiguration and The Assumption

Over the coming ten days we keep the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord and the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The two feasts are quite separate but the mysteries they celebrate are intimately linked. In the first Jesus is revealed in his glory to his disciples to strengthen them for the trial of his passion and death. In the second Mary is assumed into heaven, body and soul, in order that she might share the glory of her Son.

What is bestowed on Mary in this singular honour is revealed also to be God's plan for us, that with our sins healed and forgiven through the saving work of Jesus, we too should share in the glory of his Son. The collect (opening prayer) for the Transfiguration makes this clear when it speaks of this mystery as "prefiguring our full adoption". In other words, the glory of Jesus revealed in his human body is a glimpse of what we are to become.

That same prayer, drawing on the Gospel, also reminds us that we become coheirs by listening to the voice of the beloved Son. Listening to his voice we become transformed into his likeness. It is this phrase that I think we should pay attention to this week – *Listen to him.* Often, I speak to people who find themselves rushing from pillar to post and who long for something of the simplicity, space and slower pace of life that was the experience of many during the early months of COVID. It is something that I recognise for myself too – that part of me is crying out to slow down and listen. Peter, James and John needed to come away from Tabor, the mountain of the transfiguration. Perhaps we need to create time to climb that mountain and to listen to what the Lord has to say to each of us.

PSALM RESPONSE: The Lord is king, most high above all the earth.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION: Alleluia! Alleluia! This is my Son, the Beloved: he enjoys my favour. Listen to him.

Alleluia!

COMMUNION ANTIPHON: When Christ appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.
